

## Payment Options and Plans



Sometimes it feels like time passes too quickly to keep up with. Have you ever checked the calendar and wondered, "Where did the month go?"

This can become a problem when it comes to paying bills. At Zia Natural Gas, we offer several payment options. Please allow 5-7 business days for mail and bank processing time before your bill's due date.

We offer the following payment options:

- Mail a check or money order with your payment stub to 3700 W Picacho Ave, Las Cruces, NM 88007. Please use standard blue or black ink when writing any checks and make sure all checks have been signed.

- Drop your check or money order with your payment stub in our drop box located outside each of our office buildings.
- Sign up for EFT Bank Draft and we will draft your account balance or budget amount from your checking or savings account each month. There are no additional fees for using the EFT Bank Draft option. Sign up forms can be obtained online at [www.zngc.com](http://www.zngc.com) or in your local office.
- Use the Web Bill Pay option through your bank's website to make a payment. Talk to your banker for assistance using Web Bill Pay.
- Pay online at [www.zngc.com](http://www.zngc.com) using a credit or debit card, checking or savings account, PayPal, PayPal Credit, Venmo, Apple Pay, or Google Pay. Convenience fees may apply.
- Visit any MoneyGram location to make a payment. Convenience fees may apply. MoneyGram services are available at any Western Union or Walmart location, as well as most CVS Pharmacy and Albertsons locations. You can find additional locations at [www.moneygram.com](http://www.moneygram.com).
- Come into any of our office locations and pay with cash, check, or money order.

Our Budget Payment Plan is designed to make your budgeting easier by eliminating the ups and downs associated with seasonal heating and cooling. We average your usage over 12 months and calculate a budget payment amount that remains the same each month. This means no more surprises when you look at your monthly statement. Every October, we reevaluate your usage and adjust your monthly statement to reflect actual usage. To enroll, you must have a zero-account balance and send in a completed budget enrollment form which can be found on our website or in our local offices.

## RECIPE

### Crustless Spinach Quiche

#### INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1 tablespoon canola oil
- 1 package (10 ounces) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and well drained
- 2/3 cup finely chopped fully cooked ham
- 5 large eggs
- 3 cups shredded Muenster or Monterey Jack cheese
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper



#### DIRECTIONS

In a large skillet, sauté onion and mushrooms in oil until tender. Add spinach and ham; cook and stir until the excess moisture is evaporated. Cool slightly. Beat eggs; add cheese and mix well. Stir in spinach mixture and pepper; blend well. Spread evenly into a greased 9-in. pie plate or quiche dish. Bake at 350° for 40-45 minutes or until a knife inserted in center comes out clean.


