Would you like to know exactly what your natural gas bill will be each month, even before it arrives? What if you could pay the same monthly amount on your natural gas bill year-round, much like your car payment or mortgage? At Zia Natural Gas, we can help you do that with our Budget Payment Plan, be-

cause we know there are many reasons why families budget and whatever your reason is Zia Natural Gas is here to help.

Here's how it works; we add up your natural gas bills for one year and then divide that amount by 12. This amount becomes your monthly payment. Each month. Every month. No fluctuation. Then,

How Utility Scams Work

Utility scams can be quite alarming, but knowing how they work can help you stay safe. Here's a brief summary of what you need to know:



- The Call: Scammers pose as representatives from your gas, water, or electric company, threatening to cut off your service if you don't pay immediately.
- **PAYMENT METHODS**: They often demand payment through wiring money, reloadable cards, gift cards, or cryptocurrency because these methods are hard to trace and recover.

WHAT TO DO

- Verify: Hang up and call your utility company using the number on your bill or their official website. Don't use any numbers provided by the caller.
- **Payment Methods**: Never wire money or use reloadable cards, gift cards, or cryptocurrency to pay. Legitimate utility companies won't ask for these payment methods.

REPORTING SCAMS

- **Utility Company**: Report the scam to your utility company.
- FTC: Report it to the Federal Trade Commission at ReportFraud.ftc.gov.
